

**City of St. Clair
City Council Meeting
August 4th, 2008**

Public Hearing:

Mayor Blum called the hearing to order at 6:40 p.m.

Present were: Mayor Blum, Administrator Arndt, Alderman Davis, Alderman Pierce, Alderman Counts, Attorney Voss and Alderman Marrocco.

Public Hearing to consider the annexation of four parcels of properties into the corporate limits of St. Clair. Mayor Blum opened the hearing to discussion.

Beverly Harter asked if this was property that belongs to Franklin County and not Union. Mayor Blum stated this is property that is in Franklin County that wishes to be part of St. Clair. Mayor Blum stated this is a voluntary annexation.

Mayor Blum asked if there were any questions from the board. There was no discussion from the board.

Mayor Blum stated there are some parcels of ground being annexed into the city limits of St. Clair and asked for public comments. Joan Wells from 520-A North Commercial wanted to make some comments. She was asked to step to the podium by Attorney Voss to be heard. She had concerns about trees being trimmed. Mayor Blum stated that this public hearing was annexation of property into the city of St. Clair and there would be time at the regular meeting to address her concerns. Ms. Wells continued to speak on her issue and Attorney Voss stated this is a public hearing strictly for comments on the annexation and her concerns can be addressed in public discussion at the regular meeting.

Mayor Blum asked if there were any other comments concerning the annexation of properties into the city of St. Clair.

Mayor Blum asked for a motion to adjourn the public hearing. Alderman Marrocco made a motion to adjourn, second provided by Alderman Counts. Motion carried by voice vote. Public Hearing was closed at 7:00 pm.
